HISTORY

The institution was established in 1907 by the General Assembly as the Arkansas State Normal School. In 1925 the name was changed to the Arkansas State Teachers College, in 1967 to the State College of Arkansas, and in 1975 the institution became the University of Central Arkansas.

REPEATED COURSE DESIGNATION
